



## SOLEMNITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI

“We are what we eat,” as the saying goes. It is because when we eat the food, the food may become a part of us, a part of our flesh. Whenever we have celebrations, let’s say, birthday, wedding anniversary or anniversaries, they are always associated with food. We even entertain our visitors by offering them food to eat. Whenever we want to thank people, we eat a meal with them. We give them a blowout. In the same way, Jesus knew that soon He will leave his disciples and go back to His father and so He had a special meal with them. What He did on the first Holy Thursday was He gave a farewell meal to His followers and showed them how to celebrate the important part of the Mass. Since today we are celebrating the Feast of Corpus Christi or the feast of the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ in the Holy Mass, He showed his disciples how to get Him to come and be with them in a very special way inside the bread and wine of the Eucharist. The altar is the center of attention inside a Catholic Church. Most other Christian churches have no altars. They are just large halls which are used for prayer meetings and sermons. That is why, we, Catholics must remember that the main reason why we come to Mass on Sundays, is not only to attend Mass but to celebrate a Mass with Jesus. We go to Mass not only because we want to hear the Word of God and the sermon of the priest but also that we want to go to Communion and receive Jesus in His body. So, when we receive Jesus during communion, may I pose for suggestion: “When the priest or Eucharistic minister holds up the sacred host and says to you: “The Body of Christ,” try to realize, in a special way, what you receive, that this sacred Host is the living Body of Jesus. It is the same Jesus who was born in Bethlehem. It is the same Jesus who was nailed and died on the cross. It is the same Jesus who rose from the dead.
